As announced last weekend, Archbishop Sartain has appointed Fr. Ramon Santa Cruz to replace Fr. Tim as our pastor, effective July 1st. Fr. Ramon is a native of Quezon City, Philippines. He originally joined the Society of our Lady of the Trinity, a religious order, and did his major theology studies at the Angelicum University in Rome. He was ordained a priest in 1999 and came to the Archdiocese of Seattle in 2002. In 2006 he left his religious community and became a priest of the Archdiocese of Seattle. For the past eight years he has been pastor of St. John Mary Vianney Parish in Kirkland. Fr. Ramon is excited to be coming to our communities. He will officially begin his ministry as pastor on the weekend of July 1/2. Fr. Tim's last weekend as our pastor will be June 24/25, and he will enter "senior status" (aka retirement from full-time ministry) on June 30. A transition team of parishioners from both of our churches, under the leadership of Deacon Phil, will be working to help effect a smooth transition of pastors. Details of Fr. Tim's "farewell" and Fr. Ramon's "welcome" will be announced in coming weeks. Let us all support the transition by including our new pastor in our prayers.
